The Tennessee House of Representatives went into what may be it's last day of session for 2010 at 10:00 this morning. We recessed at 1:30 and will return to session at 3:30 this afternoon.

Today we successfully passed a budget that created no new taxes while maintaining a healthy reserve fund for our future. This budget provides vital services, offers opportunities for job growth to small businesses, gives desperately needed support to our farmers and helps thousands of Tennesseans who suffered catastrophic damage during the May floods.

The final budget, which passed the House unanimously 94-0, is a compromise budget agreed to by both Democrats and Republicans after nearly six weeks of intense negotiations. This budget was a hard budget, but it is also a responsible budget for all of Tennessee.

Hopefully I will be able to re-cap the budget highlights in my e-mail next week.

On other matters, I am attaching a copy of "Hazard Mitigation Home Buy-Out Facts" supplied by the Mayor's office. This information is for flood victims.

I would like to note this is National CPR/AED Awareness Week. The week is meant to raise public awareness of sudden cardiac arrest (suffered by more than 300,000 people each year) and increase the chance of survival by having more people trained in CPR and trained in the use of an AED (Automated External Defibrillator).
